The meeting was commenced at 02.15 p.m. Dr. K. Arul, Principal of the College welcomed the Members of the Board of Studies (BoS) and handed over the proceedings to the Chairman of the BoS, Dr. N. Gunasekaran. Dr. N. Gunasekaran introduced all the Members of the BoS and welcomed them. After a brief introduction to the duties and responsibilities of the BoS, Dr. N. Gunasekaran explained the details of Agenda and the

academic matters to be discussed. The Agenda of the Meeting was taken up for discussion. The Agenda-wise resolutions made in the Meeting are given below:

AGENDA I

Preparation of syllabi for M.A. English degree course for the academic year 2020-2021 and thereafter.

RESOLUTIONS

Dr. N. Gunasekaran submitted the prepared syllabi for the M.A. English degree course to the BoS Members and presented the same. Based on his presentation the committee members arrived at the following resolutions:

- The committee scrutinized and unanimously recommended the syllabi for the M.A. English degree course for the approval of the Academic Council after carrying out recommended modifications (20 to 30%) in selected courses.
- The committee suggested to incorporate Introduction about The Age as the first unit for each course.
- The committee recommended the incorporation of online extra credit courses (MOOC / SWAYM) for the benefit of the students.
- The committee suggested to include common programme objectives, course objectives and learning outcomes for all the courses and incorporate lecturing hours for each unit.
- It was suggested to include Books Prescribed, Reference Books and Website Sources for all the courses.
- It was suggested to frame courses codes for all the courses based on certain criteria.

AGENDA II

Formulation of methodologies for innovative teaching and evaluation techniques.

RESOLUTIONS

- ✓ The committee recommended to adopt the latest teaching-learning methods like, Blended Learning, Flip Methods, Role Plays, Simulations, Case Study Learnings Experimental Learning, Situation Analysis and ICT Based Techniques for effective class room learning and teaching.
- ✓ The committee also recommended to conduct special classes for students on various soft skills.

AGENDA III

Preparation of scheme of examinations and question paper pattern.

RESOLUTIONS

The committee discussed about the scheme of examinations and question paper pattern and unanimously arrived into the following resolutions:

- ❖ Maximum marks for theory examination will be 100 marks, out of which 75 marks will be allotted for external examination and 25 marks will be distributed for internal examination.
- ❖ Part A in external examination will be conducted in the form of Objective Type Questions (Multiple Choice Questions) for 15 marks ($15 \times 1 = 15$ marks)
- ❖ For Part B, it was suggested to conduct the examination with 6 questions, out of which 4 questions to be answered ($4 \times 5 = 20$ marks)
- ❖ 5 questions in either or pattern were suggested for Part C ($5 \times 8 = 40$ marks)
- ❖ Total duration of the examination will be 3 hours

❖ Internal Assessment for 25 marks is suggested to be followed in the following manner

- a. Written examination for 10 marks
- b. Assignment for 5 marks
- c. Seminar for 5 marks
- c. Attendance for 5 marks
