The agenda-wise resolutions made in the meeting are given below:

RESOLUTIONS

Dr. C. Ragavan screen shared and explained the prepared syllabus of the B.Sc. Mathematics, BBA and BBA (CA) Programmes to the BOS Members. Based on his presentation the Committee Members arrived into the following resolutions:

The committee clarified all the courses semester wise and unit wise in detail. The committee approved the modifications in the B.Sc. Mathematics, BBA and BBA (CA) Programme Syllabus after thorough verification.

Some of the modifications suggested in the syllabus of the B.Sc. Mathematics Programme are:

- > Course Code: 21UMAC01, Course Title: Algebra and Trigonometry
 - In Unit I, suggested to include assignments as the Energy of graphs.
- Course Code: 21UMAC02, Course Title: Logic, Sets and Boolean Algebra

- In Unit IV, suggested to incorporate subsets counting Problems, such as Sterling number of the second kind.
- ➤ In BBA & BBA(CA) Programmes, Course Code: 21UMA1BM02, Course Title: Business Mathematics & Statistics
 - Suggested to adopt MS Excel (Or) Google Spread Sheet for teaching this Course.
- ➤ The Committee approved the inclusion of Communicative English I and Communicative English II Courses prescribed by the TANSCHE, each with the Credits of 3 by replacing Foundation English I and Foundation English II Courses in the First and Second Semester, respectively of the B.Sc. Mathematics Programme.
- ➤ The committee approved the inclusion of Professional English I and Professional English II as Add-On Courses under Physical Sciences, prescribed by the TANSCHE, each with the Credits of 4 in the First and Second Semester, respectively of the B.Sc. Mathematics Programme.
- ➤ The committee approved to conduct 4 certificate courses (_LATEX, MATLAB, Office Automation, and Python) and Diploma Course (MATLAB).
- ➤ The committee approved the inclusion of LATEX Practical for B.Sc. Chemistry Programme towards the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 batch students.
- ➤ It was resolved to recommend the Panel of Question Paper Setters (31 Setters) and Question Paper Scrutinizers (5 Scrutinizers) for the approval of the Academic Council.
- ➤ It was resolved to recommend the teaching staff members with minimum teaching experience of two years in accordance with the Periyar University for evaluating the semester examination answer scripts (Both Theory and Practical).
- > It was suggested to permit eligible staff members for evaluating the Semester Examination Answer Scripts.
