Memorandum of Understanding

This Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into on this 08th day of January 2024 between St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu, represented herein by its Authorised Signatory, Rev. Dr. M Arockiasamy Xavier, SJ, hereinafter referred to as "SJC" which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof in this Agreement shall include its executors, successors and permitted assigns of the FIRST PART.

And

Sri Vidya Mandir Arts & Science College (Autonomous), a higher educational institution located at, Ketteri, Uthangarai, Krishnagiri District, Tamil Nadu, represented herein by its Authorised Signatory, Dr. N. Gunasekaran, hereinafter referred to as "SVMASC", which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof in this Agreement shall include its executors, successors and permitted assigns of the SECOND PART.

WHEREAS, SJC is in the field of imparting Education to Students, AND WHEREAS SVMASC is also an educational institution functioning from Chennai.

Both SVMASC and SJC have been referred individually as Party and jointly as Parties.

AND WHEREAS SVMASC proposes to enter into this MoU with SJC for the purpose of developing a full-fledged Content Management System and other areas. This MoU is purely for academic purposes only.

AND WHEREAS the parties to this MoU agree that this MoU shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of signing of this MoU (hereinafter referred to as the Period)

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

This is an independent non-exclusive, non-transferable agreement between the parties and the parties hereunder are free to take the services of any other third party in relation to the purpose mentioned hereinabove.

This MOU formalizes a relationship between SJC and SVMASC. The intent of the Parties is to develop a long-term mutually beneficial relationship whereby SJC will share its domain expertise with SVMASC in the field of Consultancy, Research and Extension and provide knowledge transfer to the faculty of SVMASC and any other information of common interest with SVMASC. In reciprocation SVMASC will share its expertise in activities pertaining to jointly organizing conferences and seminars and provide support in curriculum design.

Set forth below is the understanding between SJC and SVMASC:

- 1. SVMASC faculties will be trained from time to time depending upon the requirements of the SVMASC and at the convenience of the faculty of SJC.
- 2. In order to promote further scholarly exchange, both Parties shall actively consider the exchange of teaching faculty and scholars. Such exchange shall be the subject of ad hoc consultation in the future in accordance with needs and feasibility and based on mutual agreement between the parties.
- 3. Senior faculty of SVMASC will share their expertise in the design of curriculum and act as subject expert during Board of Studies.
- 4. SJC will share its domain expertise to the SVMASC faculty, provide its research expertise in scientific publications in reputed journals, study programmes, projects, organizing seminars and conferences.
- 5. Prices and payment: There are NO Monetary terms or value attached or exchanged in MoU, which is purely for purpose of promoting Academic Excellence
- 6. Periodicity: This MOU is valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of signing by both the Parties and may be reviewed and renewed on mutual consent of both Parties thereafter.
- 7. Termination: Either of the parties may terminate the Contract voluntarily if it so wishes or if it defaults or breaches any of the terms and conditions of this MoU, by giving minimum of sixty (60) days' notice to the defaulting party.

Entire agreement: SVMASC and the SJC acknowledge that they have read this agreement, understood it and agree to be bound by its terms and further agree that it is the complete and exclusive statement of the agreement between the parties, which supersedes all proposals oral or written, and all other communications between the parties relating to the subject matter of this agreement.

SVMASC and SJC look forward to implementing this mutually beneficial agreement in the common interest of helping the students of the Department of Computer Science.
