<u>Action Taken</u>: Grade Cards were issued to the students and they had been progressed to the subsequent Even Semester Examinations held during the month of May 2023.

Resolution 5: The Governing Body resolved to approve the proposal for conducting seminars, conferences and symposia with the suggestion of inviting reputed resource persons for the events.

<u>Action Taken</u>: The approved events were conducted by the departments during the even semester (Annexure – I) with reputed resource persons. The total number of events conducted was 12.

Resolution 6: The Governing Body resolved to approve number of students on roll during the academic year 2022-2023 with the suggestion of increasing students' strength for NAAC view point and NIRF Ranking.

Action Taken: The admitted students (Annexure – II) have completed their Odd and Even Semester Examinations. Steps have been taken to increase students' strength with notable progress. The total number of students admitted in UG and PG Programmes during the current Academic Year (2023-2024) is 935 and 161, respectively, which is 19 and 14%, respectively higher than that of the previous Academic Year (2022-2023).

Resolution 2: Implementation of Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education (TANSCHE) Syllabi and Framed Regulations by the Respective Board of Studies for Students Joining the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes from the Academic Year 2023-2024 onwards was Approved.

Resolution 3: Implementation of Third Year (2020-2023 Batch) Undergraduate Programmes Syllabi Recommended by the Respective Board of Studies to the Students of Third Year Undergraduate Programmes Admitted from the Academic Year 2021-2022 onwards was Approved.

<u>Resolution 14</u>: Number of Students Admitted in Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes during the Academic Year 2023-2024 was Ratified (Annexure – XII). The total number of students admitted in UG and PG Programmes during the current Academic Year (2023-2024) is 935 and 161, respectively.

<u>Resolution 15</u>: Publication of May 2023 Even Semester Examination Results of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes was Ratified (Annexure – XIII). The pass percentage of students

in I, II and III Year UG Programmes are 94.90, 97.73 and 100%, respectively and the pass percentage in I and III Year PG Programmes are 99.24 and 100%, respectively.

<u>Resolution 16</u>: Award of Degree to the Students of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes under Autonomous Mode was Approved (Annexure – XIV). In UG Programmes, 711 students and in PG Programmes 226 students will be awarded with degrees.

Resolution 17: Academic Performance of Faculty Members such as Research Articles Publication in Journals, Books/Chapters Published, Research Works Presented in Seminars/Conferences/Workshops, etc. during the academic year 2022-2023 was Ratified (Annexure – XV). A total of 36 research articles and 08 books were published, 43 research works were presented, 27 invited takes were delivered, 01 research project was applied and 02 patent were filed by the Faculty Members.

Resolution 18: Seminars/Conferences/Workshops Organized by the Departments of the College during the Even Semester was Ratified (Annexure – I).

<u>Resolution 19</u>: Organization of Science and Arts Exhibition and Exposure Visit for School Students was Ratified (Annexure – XVI).

Science and Arts Exhibition was Organized by our College in Collaboration with Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research, Kalpakkam for School and College Students on 16.02.2023 and 17.02.2023. A total of 3060 School Students from 26 Government and Private Schools and 3000 College Students were Participated in the Exhibition. A total of 321 Models (Science Model = 173 and Arts Models = 148) were displayed and demonstrated to the students. Our College Management provided free transportation, refreshments and lunch to the students. To Create Awareness about Higher Education, Exposure Visit for School Students was organized by our College on 27.02.2023. A total of 1257 School Students from 15 Government and Private Schools s were Participated in the Exposure Visit.

In addition to the above resolutions, the Academic Council suggested to establish Green House and Museum in the College.

The Governing Body resolved to approve the resolutions made during the fifth Academic Council Meeting.

Desktop computers (50 no's) and UPS (20 kVA) were purchased for the newly introduced B.Sc. Information Technology and B.Sc. Computer Science (Artificial Intelligence and Data Science)
